Dear Dr. Schlottfeldt

I wish to thank you for your letter 174/CSS/ZB of April 26, which reached me on Friday last.

Since writing to you on April 20th, I received on April 23rd the letter from Mr. Gillette of the Rockefeller Foundation, dated April 10th. Unfortunately the Rockefeller Foundation, New York, sent their letter of April 10th by regular mail and not by airmail. Immediately on receipt of the letter I started processing this order against the following proforma invoices:

I had asked the Rockefeller Foundation to let me have a Letter of Credit, but they did not feel like doing so, and as per Mr. Gillette's letter, it will be necessary for me, in order to receive payment from the Rockefeller Foundation, to submit my invoices to you which you in turn would forward with your approval for payment to the Rockefeller Foundation.

I will most probably have to make several part shipments, and as soon as my invoices are written, I will send same to you in triplicate asking you to check them and forward one copy immediately to the Rockefeller Foundation with your approval for payment.

Inasmuch as a considerable amount of money is involved, I would like to have your kind assurance now that you would check my invoices and forward them, with your approval, to New York with the least possible delay, that is within two or three weeks after receipt. Please be kind enough to confirm this.

Re: Invoicing



Should there be any other rules and regulations to be observed in the making out of my invoices, please let me have the necessary instructions as early as possible.

In closing, I wish to thank you for this nice order, which will have my very best attention.

My agent in Belo Horizonte, Mr. Alfred A. von Smigay, has been requested to assist you in every respect. May I suggest that, when writing me, you make it a rule to always send him a copy?
