Dear Dr. Schlottfeldt:

May I acknowledge your letter of December 10 to Dr. Miller with the information regarding the two candidates your Local Committee wishes to nominate for scholarships to the Mexican Agricultural Program. We would like to commend your committee for the selection of students with the high academic standing their records show.

Soil conservation, the field in which they would like to work, is not a field in which staff members of the Mexican Program give training, but agronomy, soils science and other subjects closely related to soil conservation do form a part of the general program on the improvement of the basic food crops in Mexico. If the nominees, Mr. Ubirajara and Mr. Moura, would like to enter the Mexican Program on scholarships in agronomy and soils science, we shall be glad to proceed with the steps necessary for presenting to our Committee in New York the information regarding their training, background and experience. Accordingly, I am asking Dr. R. B. Watson of our Rio office to forward to you as soon as possible the modified personal history and fellowship application form which we use for recording the necessary data for scholars, and I am also asking that he make the arrangements for these two students to take a physical examination which they must pass satisfactorily before they can fully qualify for scholarships.

When all of the information on the application forms, which Dr. Watson will forward to you, and when the results of the medical examination are before us, we shall present these documents to our Committee in New York with the recommendation that action be taken promptly in order that these young agronomos may be able to start their period of training as early as possible in 1955, provided their qualifications have been found to be satisfactory.
